Important Information About Overdraft and Overdraft Fees

An overdraft occurs when you do not have enough available funds in your checking account to cover a transaction and the Credit Union pays it anyway. Sikorsky Credit Union offers protection to your account in two different ways:

- 1. Standard overdraft protection services, which automatically comes with your checking account. Standard overdraft protection includes:
 - Our Overdraft Privilege Service.
 - The ability to link your savings account to cover overdrafts (i.e.: Overdraft transfer from Savings, which may be less expensive than Overdraft Privilege Service).
- Personal Line One Line of Credit, which you may apply for. To learn more, ask a Credit Union representative about this service. (This service may be less expensive than Overdraft Privilege Service).

YOU MUST "OPT-IN" FOR OVERDRAFT COVERAGE ON ATM TRANSACTIONS AND ONE-TIME DEBIT CARD TRANSACTIONS

What You Need to Know About Our Overdraft Privilege Service

What is the Overdraft Privilege Service that comes with my checking account? (Basic Coverage)

- 1. Sikorsky Credit Union will authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:
 - Checks and other transactions (ACH withdrawals, e.g., automatic payments and debits) made using your checking account number.
 - Online banking transfers and online bill payments from your checking account.
 - Recurring debit card transactions (e.g., monthly bills charged to your debit card).
 - Cashing a Sikorsky Credit Union check at a teller.
- 2. Sikorsky Credit Union **will not** authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (**opt- in below**).
 - ATM transactions.
 - One-time debit card transactions (e.g., everyday debit card purchases).
- 3. Sikorsky Credit Union pays overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay every type of transaction. If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

What fees will I be charged if Sikorsky Credit Union pays my overdraft?

- 1. When you utilize the Overdraft Privilege Service (basic coverage):
 - We will charge you a Fee of \$33 each time we pay an overdraft.
 - We will not charge you a fee for transactions of \$10 or less.
 - The maximum fees we will charge you for overdrawing your account is up to \$99 per day. (Fees include Overdraft and/or Returned Non-Sufficient Funds Fees)
